ROMAN CATHOLIC PRIEST AND MINISTERS OF OTHER FAITHS

London Bridge Hospital has links with Guy's Hospital Spiritual Care Team to provide multi-faith support. A Roman Catholic Priest is available and can be contacted via Gillian or out of hours via the Senior Sister in charge of the hospital.

Whilst London Bridge Hospital does not have a Chapel, relatives and visitors may like to visit Southwark Cathedral.



Southwark Cathedral is an Anglican Cathedral dedicated to St Saviour and St Mary Overie and is situated on Bankside at the south side of London Bridge. It is within a 2-3 minute walk of the hospital and can be found by turning right out of the main entrance and walking along under London Bridge to the Cathedral, which you will see on the left.
