

Travelling to London Bridge Hospital

Directions: London Bridge Hospital is situated on the south side of the River Thames. We are next to London Bridge mainline and underground stations with easy access to the City.

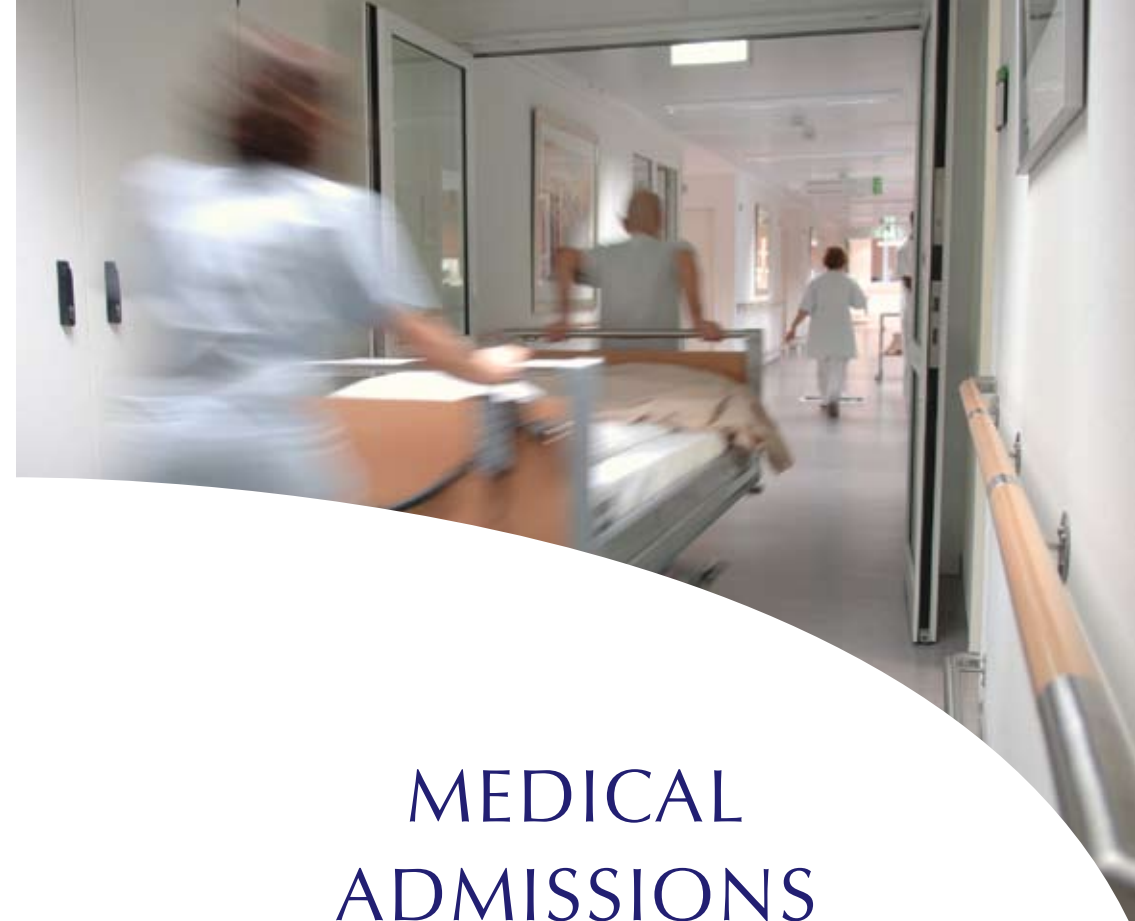
Train: London Bridge Station is serviced by trains from Kent and Surrey and offers direct connections to Charing Cross, Cannon Street, Waterloo East and Blackfriars Stations. Trains also connect directly on the Thameslink line.

Underground: London Bridge Station is on the Jubilee Line and Northern Line (City Branch).

By Car: There are no car parking facilities available at the hospital. There is limited parking nearby. Patients can be dropped off and collected by car or taxi outside the main door of the hospital, where 15 minutes parking is available.

Taxi: The hospital reception can book taxis for patients and visitors through our local taxi company, alternatively, black cabs are available at London Bridge Station.

Buses: There are numerous buses that pass by the hospital on Tooley Street, from London Bridge, or from outside the main entrance of the London Bridge Station.

The Medical Admissions Service is an instant, expert referral system for a patient who requires an urgent general medical consultant opinion – available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Chronic Renal Failure, Dialysis, Gynaecology, Obstetrics, Orthopaedics, Paediatrics and Surgical referrals are also not included in this service.

- 12 Critical Care beds staffed by 36 Critical Care nurses
- On-site 24-hour anaesthetist and on-site 24-hour surgical RMO
- 4 Consultant Intensivists offering 24-hour cover, 365 days a year
- On-site theatre team and on-site resuscitation team
- 24-hour Radiology and Pathology service



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
