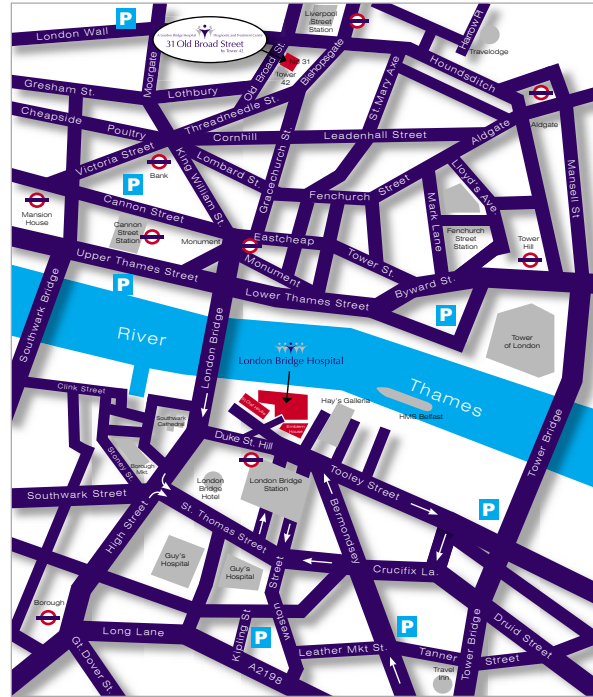

## GALLSTONE CLINIC

London Bridge Hospital's Gallstone Clinic draws on the expertise of the country's leading Hepatobiliary and Pancreatic unit at King's College, London. The team comprises a group of dynamic surgeons, hepatologists, gastroenterologists and radiologists who are responsible for many of the latest advances in liver and pancreatic diseases and cancer research today.

Consultants at our clinic specialise solely in the field of hepatobiliary and pancreatic problems and all aspects of most up-to-date treatments. Our small team of professionals allows us to provide you with a personal and specialised service.

## EASE OF ACCESS

The One Stop Gallstone Clinic has been set up at London Bridge Hospital and 31 Old Broad Street to provide rapid advice, diagnosis and treatment for anyone who may have a gallbladder problem. Our aim is to offer this service in the most convenient and professional way. We offer appointments 2 days a week with the advantage of providing all hepatobiliary and pancreatic services under one roof.

The hospital is only 50 yards from London Bridge rail and Underground stations and within easy reach of both the city and the southeast. (See map on the reverse)

### YOUR CONSULTATION

Your consultant will assess your current symptoms and, if required, can identify the problem through a series of diagnostic procedures. These diagnostic tests can be performed without delay at the clinic, with no need to wait for a second appointment and all the anxiety and inconvenience that this may cause.

The range of diagnostic tests and other services available at the clinic include:

- Liver function tests
- Ultrasound scanning

If you need any of these tests you will be accompanied by one of our team and the results of the investigations will be assessed on site by a consultant surgeon and a consultant radiologist.

Your visit will conclude with another meeting with your consultant who will discuss your results with you and any further steps that may be needed.

Your visit will take approximately 1 – 2.5 hours. Before attending your clinic appointment you should not eat or drink for 4 hours.

## CLINIC TIMES

We hold 2 One Stop Clinics each week at the following times:

Monday 16.00 – 18.00

Thursday 15.30 – 19.00

If you would like to make an appointment, please contact the GP Liaison department on 0207 234 2009 or 2120. They will find the most convenient appointment and send you a confirmation of your appointment. They can also help you with any additional information you may require.

You will need to bring with you to your appointment your GP details and referral letter, if you have one. If you are insured you will also need to bring your policy details. We also welcome patients who are self funding their treatment.

London Bridge Hospital is recognised by most major health insurers but you should check to ensure that your policy will cover your treatment before you attend the clinic.
